Founded in 1986, we are one of the largest non-shelter housing providers for low-income families in Columbus, working alongside landlords, government agencies, and community partners to provide safe, secure, and affordable housing solutions to over 1,200 families experiencing housing crises each year.

Housing

With a family-centric philosophy, our case managers partner with families and youths in crisis to provide vital case management, housing interventions, and eviction prevention planning.

Family Stabilization

We provide a range of material supports, such as food and household essentials, as well as connections to community resources to help families and youths avoid crises.

Education

Our SPARK Kindergarten Readiness (ages 3-6), Afterschool, and Summer Achievers programs (ages 5-12) focus on crucial academic and healthy social-emotional skills for young learners.
